Matters Arising:

- a) Recreation Ground. Councillor Beryl Wright has been contacted regarding the recreation ground. A copy of the original letter from RMBC dated 22nd November 1989 (stating work may be carried out in the summer of 1990) has been passed on to her.
- b) Minutes of each meeting are to be sent to the following:

- c) Wardle Commemorative Wood. Tom Seed has now collected all the sponsor-a-tree forms, so that he can start the register, which will be duplicated and a copy kept in the library. B.T.C.V. and Community Leisure will be fencing off the land during September. Rabbit guards and canes have been provided. Tom will contact the Society as soon as a planting date has been decided upon. Community Leisure are to be contacted about making the benches.

Any Other Business;

1. The Newsletter was not published before the A.G.M. as it was decided there would be more news after this (August) meeting.
2. The Wardle Society meetings will be held in the library on the first Thursday of every month starting at 7.45pm.
3. The sale of the Chapels will be carefully monitored by the Society.
4. A letter has been sent by the North West Civic Trust with information on Country Planning. The booklets received are to be put on our noticeboard.
5. It was suggested that our guided walks could vary from time to time and a full day out to another area may be appreciated.
6. A visit to York, on October 20th, was suggested if enough people are interested. Members of the Society can contact Margaret in the library if they wish to participate.
7. Following up on the 'crossing' island in Crossfield Road. Technical Services are investigating the feasibility.
8. A request has been made to Wardle Art Group to prepare posters about the dangers of swimming etc in Watergrove Reservoir. Margaret will make some posters aimed at parents.
9. In a discussion about re-inviting village groups to become corporate members of Wardle Society it was decided to send copies of the next newsletter to the various organisations.
10. It has been decided to try to revive the Pace Egg for Easter 1992 and we will sponsor the costumes etc.
