SECRETARY'S REPORT : We have received a letter from Winnie Flatley who wishes to resign from the Wardle Civic Society . Jane will send a letter of reply.

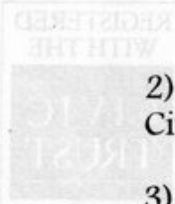
A letter and magazine has been received from Tree News. The information is on display in the Library.
