PLANNING MATTERS : The Society has serious objections to the planning sort for D35041 and D35042 in the Wardle Conservation Area. A letter will be sent from the Wardle Civic Society listing our concerns as this is not the first time that

old buildings have been allowed to be pulled down in the Conservation Area.

**POLICE MATTERS :** We were told by Keith , our community Policeman that the police presence has been increased in Wardle this past month and would continue at that level for the moment.

**ANY OTHER BUSINESS:** The footpath walk for February will not take place due to members who usually take part having family commitments.
