**Conservation Area :- Brown Cow Farm** We have had a letter from Planning re. the garage. It says that it is acceptable but not perfect.

**Cottage** We have had no news on the cottage, with the back wall down, in Wardle Fold and are to write again to ask why RMBC are not getting results in this matter.

**Church** We have not had any news about the future of the Church.

**Hanging Baskets :-** We have had a letter from RMBC Rec & Amenities. They hope to improve the baskets this summer.

**Wardle Road, Halifax Road Roundabout :-** We have had a letter from Technical Services regarding accident reports for the above location and whilst records show a problem negotiating the mini roundabout itself the approach arm from Wardle Road does not indicate any problems. A suggestion to improve road markings is to be pursued.

We have also received a letter regarding the speed limit through Wardle. There are no plans for 30mph signs as the street lighting, in the absence of signs to the contrary, means that the speed limit is 30mph.

**Goal Posts :-** These have to be removed so that the area can be used for cricket and repairs and reseeding of the goal areas can be done during the summer.
