Stone Wall Wardle Road: - Repairs to the wall have been completed.

Inaccessible Footpaths: - Bernice is of the opinion that the definitive map is to be completed by 30th November.

All Weather Pitch: - Ashley reported that the all weather pitch is not feasible because of cost and the likelihood of vandalism, but will be registered with the government in hope for the future.

Walkabout: - Ashley had information arising from the walkabout we had in August. They were, Garden at the community Centre should be maintained by the council. Dog fouling signs on Clough Street are to be replaced and are also to hold warnings of motorbikes etc., swings will be inspected weekly. Trees overhanging footpath at Field House, owner is to be informed with a view to him/her dealing with them. Footpath at the rear of the Globe Inn has been cleared as have various gulleys. No spring flowers anywhere in the borough.

Any Other Business: - Suggestions were made to have more hanging baskets, perhaps concentrating on one area each year. Maybe it would be possible to have a large plant container outside the library and the containers on the square could be replaced.

Bernice voiced her concern about a TV mast at Bank Cottages. It seems that a lot of work has been done on it recently and she suspected that it could be a phone mast.
