**Moorside Gardens:** – Ashley has been informed by planning, that the stone wall will run on the frontage of Ramsden Road, plus 12 meters along Fern Street. The remainder of the wall on East Street will be of brick. Barretts have also stated that the roofs of the dwellings will be of Marley Edgemere tiles which should be in keeping with the ethos of the village.

Barretts have also agreed to provide a link onto Crossfield Road, also gates to the boundary with Lea Way and Haymaker Rise if required and providing the residents of these 2 estates agree. It will be the responsibility of the Society to canvass these residents. Ted Bolton is to take this on board.
