Planning: – the owners of East Top Barn have put in an application for a stable and 151 Ramsden Road are looking to split the property into two as it was originally. Coronation Power appeal still being held at Bamford RUFC Jane and Barbara have attended a couple of sessions. Jane to contact Ashley re the situation of the Halfway House. Recent update, 10th March, Coronation Power have withdrawn their application for land swap but will be looking to reapply in the next few weeks, there had been found to be some discrepancies in the maps used they seemed to have different scales from those required.

Spring Clean: Eddie has contacted the Scouts and they are willing to help. Brownies have been approached and Janet is to contact the Guides, St James School has also been spoken to. We are looking to produce 10 posters to put up around the village.

MoorEnd: All the 23 residents who attended a recent meeting were against the project but those responding to a flier, some 30, were in favour. £2,700.00, Lottery Funding which needs to be spent before May 14th, is to be spent on a walkway between Wardle Road and Birch Road; this will be subject to the agreement of the Landowners and Rochdale Council.

AOB: Steve Barlow is setting up a web site for Wardle Society, currently there is a temporary one, the domain name will cost £8 for two years, and there will also be a monthly cost which we have agreed to cover.
